

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It's important to understand that LDN's effects and ideal dosage vary person-toperson. While some might see benefits within weeks, others may need up to 4-6 months for noticeable improvements.

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS: TYPICALLY MILD & SHORT-LIVED.

If an LDN dose is too high, mild symptoms can arise, especially during the initial titration phase or when increasing the dosage. In such cases, a dose reduction is recommended.

- Queasy, upset stomach or other GI issues constipation, diarrhea; thought to be a detoxification effect
- Headaches, tiredness, or fatigue
- Muscle or joint aches
- Vivid dreams; sleep disturbances
- Possibly a minor change in mood or anxiety

Please contact us if you are experiencing any negative symptoms. We can discuss if a dosage adjustment is necessary.

WHAT TO EXPECT—
